Mr. Halpern, 1953 cum laude graduate of the University of Buffalo Law School, received a Bachelor of Arts degree in Mathematics from the University at Buffalo in 2006. Mr. Halpern is one of only a few attorneys now practicing in Western New York, and the last to have graduated from UB Law School, to have earned his law degree under former standards where an undergraduate degree was not mandatory for admission to law school. Sixty years after matriculating as an undergraduate student at UB, Mr. Halpern completed the requirements to earn his undergraduate degree in mathematics. He is admitted to practice law in New York State.
